

Conditions of participation

INITIATOR OF THE EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION 2008

Initiators and organizers of the EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION 2008 (GALILEO Masters) are the Anwendungszentrum GmbH Oberpfaffenhofen and the Messe München GmbH. They support this competition jointly.

PATRONAGE

The EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION 2008 (GALILEO Masters) is performed under the patronage of the Bavarian Ministry of Economics, Transport, Infrastructure and Technology.

SUBJECT MATTER OF THE COMPETITION

Within the EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION (ideas competition) the initiators intend with the EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION 2008 to gather ideas for commercial applications of satellite navigation and promote individual ideas by prizes.

RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE

Entitled to participate in the EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION 2008 are adult individuals, enterprises, as well as scientific institutions.

TIME LIMITS OF THE EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION 2008

(submittal deadline)

You are requested to electronically submit your contributions and ideas May 1st, 2008 until July 31st, 2008 12.00 p.m. (refer to the procedure given below).

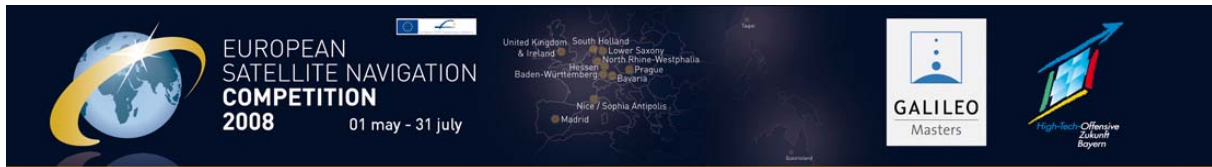
PROCEDURE

Performance and handling of the competition will be exclusively in English and via the Internet. You can therefore only enter your ideas via the Internet using the input mask under the web address www.galileo-masters.com in English. You may temporarily save and process the inputs and statements for your idea on the server until they have the form requested by you.

With your login you must choose your password, with which you have access to your saved data ("your account").

Prior to availability of a password you must maintain specific personal data that is electronically saved, used and processed for the performance of the competition and awarding of the prizes.

With your login you already decide by which regional expert team your idea is to be pre-evaluated for the initiators and in which region you would like to participate. There will be one expert group in Bavaria, Hessen, Baden-Württemberg, Nice Sophia-Antipolis, United Kingdom & Ireland, Prague, South Holland, Madrid, North Rhine-Westphalia, Lower Saxony,



Taiwan and Australia. Consequently, the regions mean Germany / Bavaria, Germany / Hessen, Germany / Baden-Württemberg, Germany / North Rhine-Westphalia, Germany / Lower Saxony, France / Nice Sophia-Antipolis, United Kingdom & Ireland, Czech Republic / Prague, Netherlands / South Holland, Spain / Madrid, Taipei / Taiwan and Queensland / Australia.

Input of your idea and filling out of mandatory data and mandatory fields of the input masks must be completed no later than July 31st, 2008 12.00 p.m. The idea will participate in the competition in the form and content it has on July, 31st 2008 at 12.00 p.m. Your idea will only be evaluated if all mandatory data is supplied and the mandatory fields in the input mask are completely filled out by July 31st, 2008 at 12.00 p.m.

SPECIAL TOPIC PRIZES

Participants in the European Satellite Navigation Competition 2008 also have the option of competing for four special topic prizes sponsored by industry and research partners.

With your login you also decide whether you would like to also enter your idea for one of the special topic prizes awarded by the following companies / institutions: T-Systems Enterprise Services GmbH, Deutsche Post AG, European Space Agency, European GNSS Supervisory Authority and Industrial Technology Research Institute of Taiwan.

These prizes will be awarded independently of participation in the European Satellite Navigation Competition 2008. The expert teams working at the regional level on behalf of the European Satellite Navigation Competition 2008 will receive no indication as to whether any participant is also competing for one of the special topic prizes. Each of these partner companies will have their own expert team to evaluate the ideas registered for one of the special topic prizes.

Each prize will be awarded to an idea for a solution or application based on its usefulness in completing certain tasks devised by AZO and the respective industry or research partner. The industry and research partners thus stand to gain innovative solution approaches to specific problems and issues. The assignment criteria can be viewed in detail under "Special Topic Prizes".

The winner of the prize awarded by T-Systems and DHL will receive the opportunity to realise an innovation project together with T-Systems, which could lead to a long-term partnership.

The winner of the prize awarded by the European GNSS Supervisory Authority will get the opportunity to realise his/her idea at a suitable incubation centre of choice within the EU27 for up to 12 months.

The winner of the prize awarded by the European Space Agency (ESA) will receive comprehensive commercial and technical assistance in order to set up their business including incubation in one of the ESA Business Incubation Centres (Noordwijk NL, Darmstadt GER, Frascati IT).

The winner of the prize awarded by the Industrial Technology Research Institute of Taiwan (ITRI) will receive a cash award of €20,000 and the travel expenses to cover a visit to Taiwan for a week.

Any participant wishing to compete for one of the special topic prizes can indicate as much while registering for the European Satellite Navigation Competition 2008. Participants must only agree to the following by checking the corresponding box in the online database:



I plan to compete for the following special topic prize and hereby agree to the rules following hereafter:

- Industrial Technology Research Institute of Taiwan

Checking none of the boxes will be taken as an indication of non-participation.

Participants who declare their intention to compete for a special topic prize also agree to grant the respective industry or research sponsor insight into the solutions and applications they submit. Each submission will only be passed on in coordination with AZO when the respective industry partner has signed a non-disclosure agreement, in which the partner pledges, for example, that data, findings, and knowledge of any kind made accessible in the course of the special topic prize competition will be kept confidential and will not be divulged to third parties. In cases where the respective industry partner expresses interest in making use of a participant's solution or application, the participant is free to arrange separate terms with the industry partner. If expressly desired by both parties, AZO will function as intermediary in the subsequent negotiations.

AWARDING OF PRIZES

The regional expert teams will select at their discretion, for each participating region up to two ideas, which will undergo a final qualification (regional finalists).

Out of these regional finalists and the special topic winners, an international expert team will select the GALILEO Master 2008. He will be given the GALILEO Masters Award 2008 for his idea. The ceremony for the GALILEO Master 2008, the regional finalists and the special topic winners will take place on the occasion of the SYSTEMS 2008 trade fair in Munich on October 21st 2008 in the Munich Residence.

The main prize will be a grant of EUR 20,000, awarded by the Anwendungszentrum GmbH Oberpfaffenhofen and the European GNSS Supervisory Authority. In addition, the GALILEO Master will get the chance to enter a 6-months incubation programme in his favoured region to realize his idea.

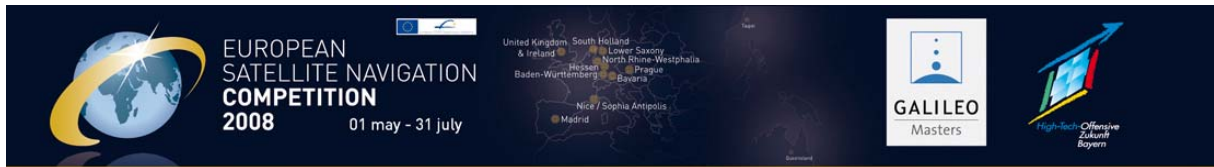
The GALILEO Master (overall winner) as well as the regional winners (finalists) may present themselves for free at a stand at the international SYSTEMS IT and telecommunication trade fair in Munich from 21st to 24th October 2008, to make first business contacts for their business idea and test its market value.

Jurisdiction of the courts against the decision of the award is excluded.

CONFIDENTIALITY

We have taken measures in the EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION 2008, to make the confidential treatment of your transmitted idea possible. The transmitted ideas and the saved treatment statuses will be protected against any access by unauthorized third parties. The personnel and experts charged with the performance of the competition are committed to treat all matters confidentially.

During the awards ceremony, apart from the prize winner identification, the awarded ideas will also be made public.



TITLE

As far as you hold the titles to your idea, such titles remain with you. It is at your discretion to realize your ideas by yourself, or with a partner selected by you. Through participation in the EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION 2008, you will not acquire any title to the idea. We strongly recommend that you discuss the protection of your idea with experts experienced in this field (e. g. patent agents, lawyers). You may protect your idea by applying for a patent, utility model, or another right of protection.

Prior to your participation in the competition, you should notify your employer of your idea if you have developed it under or in connection with your employment. As far as ideas or parts thereof submitted by you are subject to rights of protection (e.g. patents), held by you or third parties, or if such rights are applied, you have to inform the initiators (data field in input mask).

Through your participation in the EUROPEAN SATELLITE NAVIGATION COMPETITION 2008 and/or through the publication of the idea during the awards ceremony, any protection of your idea (if not prior protected by applying for a patent) may be excluded or lost. Your idea may become common property. We strongly recommend that you protect your idea sufficiently.

Despite all our efforts to keep your idea/information confidential prior to the publication of the idea/information, you understand and agree that we do not assume any liability for any damage resulting from your idea/information becoming public.

MISCELLANIOUS

The participation in this competition shall be governed by German law. Place of jurisdiction shall be Munich.
