The eighth IranConMin which took place in Tehran from 29 June – 02 July 2008, was again a great success:

- > 246 exhibitors
- > 31,800 visitors
- > 16,000 sqm

Exhibitors 2008

In total 246 companies (145 national, 101 international) took part, among them industry leaders such as Liebherr, Volvo, Wirth, Hyundai, Sermak, Jun Jin, Atlas Copco, Liu Gong and Komatsu. Companies from China, Italy and Germany exhibited in national pavilions.

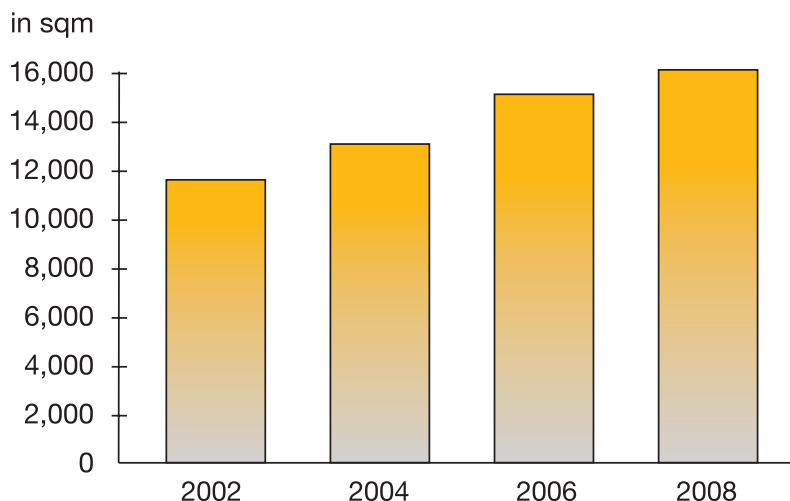

Location

IranConMin 2010 is being held in Tehran, which is situated in the north-central part of Iran and about 1,200 m above sea level. As the national capital, Tehran is the most populated city in Iran (14 million inhabitants) and the centre of cultural, economic, political and social activities.

Tehran's Permanent Fair Ground is located in the northern part of the city and is accessible from a network of city routes. It has 120,000 sqm of indoor space and 45,000 sqm of outdoor exhibition space. It hosts about 20 international fairs per year.

Iran – a growing market

with enormous potential

Enormous potential in Iran

Iran is a key political and economic centre in the region. It has 70 million inhabitants and rich natural resources. Together with the adjacent regions, it comprises a total of 300 million consumers. Geographically Iran occupies a key position at the gateway to Central Asia. Iran's economic potential has improved as a result of its growing importance in the entire region, the high price of oil exports in recent years and continuing strong interest in high-quality capital goods.

Iran – a growing market

- > Largest internal market in the Middle East
- > Improved general economic framework for investors
- > A gateway to growing adjacent markets
- > Gross domestic product is expanding at a constant rate of over 5% per year and in 2007/2008 even by 7.8%
- > Exports 2008: US\$ 113.4 billion f.o.b. (+14%)
- > Imports 2008: US\$ 67.8 billion f.o.b. (+17%)

Construction industry

Excellent opportunities for the international construction machinery industry arise from the strong demand for housing, necessary infrastructure expansion and modernisation, and not least also from the expansion and modernisation of industrial plant and production facilities.

Planned projects include:

- > Rail link Iran – Azerbaijan, 350 km, construction time 8 years, total investment US\$ 600 million.
- > Experts say Iran needs 30 new cement works
- > Hamedan cement works, total investment US\$ 100 million
- > Many earthquake-resistant buildings in the next ten years, total investment US\$ 140 billion
- > Planned up to 2010 - 4.3 million new residential units.

Mining industry

- > Growth in mining sector in 2007/2008 by 25%
- > High requirement for technology for exploration and mining of raw materials deposits
- > Iran is rich in metallic and non-metallic mineral reserves
- > Iran is in the Top 5 for deposits of natural stone
- > Large reserves of iron and non-ferrous ores, decorative stone, precious metals etc. from over 2,500 active mines
- > Largest zinc reserves worldwide and second highest reserves of copper.

Natural stone industry

Iran has a long tradition of working with stone, and extensive use of this material is in evidence at the country's fascinating sites of unique beauty.

- > Iran has one of the world's largest natural stone reserves
- > Currently an amount of more than 10 million tonnes is being extracted annually from more than 500 quarries
- > More than 3,330 stone-working plants
