India is a booming market for international suppliers

Spotlight on India – trade fairs open the door to a growth market

India is fast becoming one of the most interesting growth markets in Asia, and therefore the world. A survey presented by the Deutsche Bank forecast that by 2020 India would overtake China as the fastest expanding economy in the world. Already, in terms of purchasing power parity, the country occupies fourth place in the world rankings. Gross domestic product in India grew by 8.4% in 2005 and 2006, and the forecast for 2007 is around 8.3%. In 2006 gross investment accounted for 30.1% of GDP.

Particularly favourable influences on India's growth are its demographic development, rising investment in education and infrastructure and the increasing involvement in the world economy. Industrial sectors boosting this growth are information and communication technology, textiles, automobile and automotive components production and pharmaceuticals. India also benefits from its efficient financial market.

Resolute economic reforms and structural changes were among the factors that promoted this growth. In addition, with the help of international investments, major advances were made in the privatisation of India's government-owned enterprises. Easier conditions for imports and exports also contributed to India's leading position on the South Asian market.



India is moving more and more into the spotlight of international trade and industry. IMAG is responding to this development by providing a tailor-made trade-fair programme of international standard at the right locations.
